**RE : CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL ARCHITECTURE WEEK (NAW) 2019**

Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 934 issued by then President Ferdinand E. Marcos dated November 18, 1971, the UAP will be celebrating the **National Architecture Week (NAW) 2019 on December 8-14, 2019**. A detailed program of NAW 2019 Celebration can be accessed at UAP Website.

This year's theme: **"Abot-TaNAW: Tahanan para sa lahat!"** aims to uphold the ideals of the Architecture Community in rendering assistance in one of the country's major concerns; and that is, the marginal backlog in housing.

The United Architects of the Philippines, in coordination with its Student Auxiliary launched a design competition to intensify the artistic and creative abilities of Architecture students, showcasing and exemplifying their conceptualization and analyzing skills with their sense of empathy to the reality of the housing sector in the present era.
