RE : UAP ANNUAL NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP DUES AMNESTY PROGRAM

Pursuant to the desire of the current administration to restore the good standing status of UAP Members and their active participation in all UAP activities, and in consideration of the financial difficulties being faced by some of our colleagues that have resulted in accumulation of unpaid annual national membership dues the National Board of Directors in its regular meeting held last December 8, 2018 passed and approved Board Resolution No. 18-19 No.4-043 adopting the One-Time General Amnesty Program for Past UAP National Annual Membership Dues. Arrears on Chapter Dues are not covered by this Amnesty Program.

The following are the guidelines and procedures on General Amnesty Program for Past UAP National Annual Membership Dues:

1. Coverage

All interested UAP Members who are delinquent in the payment of their UAP Annual National Membership Dues since membership with the UAP until Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

- Submit the Form to UAP National Office as properly endorsed by the Chapter President.
- Pay the required dues pursuant to the table of payment.
- Receive the Membership Certificate from the UAP National for the Fiscal Year 2018-2019.

5. Terms and Conditions

- This program is made available to all UAP members who have arrears but have not availed of amnesty in the past. A member may avail of amnesty only once throughout his/her UAP Membership.

- e. The Membership Status of the delinquent UAP Member who availed the Amnesty Program shall start on the Fiscal Year 2018-2019.
