SUBJECT: UAP SEAL DESIGN COMPETITION

GREETINGS - FELLOW ARCHITECT!

This is the first information circular coming from your newly elected Board.

The first activity of the newly elected board was the celebration of a Thanksgiving Mass at my residence, Monday, December 18, 1978. It was attended by some chapter presidents and their families who were available at that time. Following the Mass was a breakfast after which an informal session of those present was conducted.

It was agreed during this session that a design for the official seal of the UAP be made through a competition among UAP chapter members. In order that the seal could be used in the letterhead, I find it urgent to make this announcement before our official ascendancy to office.

REQUIREMENTS OF THE COMPETITION

A. Qualification of Competitors

A-1 All UAP members in good standing are qualified upon certification of the Chapter Presidents.

B. Drawings

B-1 All drawings must be done in black ink on white illustration board measuring 6 inches by 8 inches.

B-2 The design of the seal can be of any shape (circular, oval, triangular, square, etc.).

However, the scale of the drawing must measure approximately 4 inches in diameter, length or width.

B-3 The seal must contain the following:

UNITED ARCHITECTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, 1975

B-4 Nothing must be included in the face of the illustration board except the drawing and the words "Design Competition for the UAP seal".

B-5 At the back of the illustration board, indicate the following information:

- a. Name of designer
- b. UAP Chapter
- c. Attestation by writing the following:

This is to attest that the designer is a member of good standing of our chapter

C. Delivery

Drawings must not be folded and must be properly protected by additional boards on both faces. Place it in a thick manila paper envelop. and send to (by mail or messenger):

D. Prizes

First Prize - ₱ 1,000.00 for the designer plus
2,000.00 for the chapter

Second Prize - ₱ 500.00 for the designer plus
1,000.00 for the chapter

E. Jury

The jury shall be composed of five members to be designated at a later date.

We hope that you would participate and would give your ideas on this important design of our seal.
